In exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 31(2) and 31(3) of the Cochin University Act (Act 30 of 1971), the Senate has made the following amendments to the First Statutes 1980. These amendments are effective from the 18th day of April 1983, the date of assent by the Chancellor.

1. "That the following additional statutes be incorporated as Statutes 93 (viii) and 93 (ix) respectively under chapter V-Faculties.

"93 (viii) Faculty of Environmental Studies"

"93 (ix) Such other Faculties as may be instituted by the Senate from time to time".

With the additions incorporated, Statute 93 will read thus:

"93 - Faculties:

The following shall be the Faculties in the University namely:-

- (i) The Faculty of Humanities
- (ii) The Faculty of Law
- (iii) The Faculty of Marine Sciences
- (iv) The Faculty of Science
- (v) The Faculty of Social Sciences

- (ix) Such other Faculties as may be instituted by the Senate from time to time"

2. (a) "That the following new Statute be incorporated as Chapter XII-A 'Chapter XII-A. Faculty of Environmental Studies' ".

(b) "That the following statute be incorporated under Chapter XII-A, Statutes 154(a), 154(b) and 154(c)".

"154 (a) Degrees:

The Degrees under the Faculty of Environmental Studies shall be:

- (i) Doctor of Philosophy Ph.D.
- (ii) Doctor of Science D.Sc.

"154(b) Other Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates:

The University may award any other Degree or Diploma or Certificate as may be instituted from time to time in the Faculty of Environmental Studies".

"154(c) The Degree shall be awarded as per conditions stipulated in the Regulations for the award of such degrees".

Chapter XII-A will read as follows:

"Chapter XII-A

FACULTY OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

"154 (a) Degrees:

The Degrees under the Faculty of Environmental Studies shall be:

- (i) Doctor of Philosophy Ph.D.
- (ii) Doctor of Science D.Sc.

"154 (b) Other Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates:

The University may award any other Degree or Diploma or Certificate as may be instituted from time to time in the Faculty of Environmental Studies".

"154 (c) The Degrees shall be awarded as per conditions stipulated in the Regulations for the award of such degrees".

B. (i) Amendments to statutes 201 to 225 under Chapter XXII ~ Convocation for conferring Degrees and Statute 226 under Chapter XXIII of the First Statutes of February 1980.

- I. That Statutes 201 to 225 under Chapter XXII of the First Statutes, 1980 be deleted.
- II. That the title of Chapter XXII "Convocation for conferring Degrees" be replaced by "Award of Degrees".
- III. That the following new statutes be made:

201. Award of Degrees:

- 1) Degrees shall be awarded at any ordinary meeting of the Senate.
- 2) All degrees except Honorary degrees shall be awarded in absentia.

202. Date of application:

Candidates for degrees must submit to the Registrar their applications for degrees in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee, remitted in the prescribed manner 30 clear days before any meeting of the Senate.

203. Fees:

A candidate applying for a degree shall pay a fee of Rs.20/--, which shall be in addition to the fees prescribed for the various Diplomas.

204. Applications to be made in the prescribed manner:

/has

- 1) No candidate who applied without the fee prescribed or who has not applied in the manner prescribed before the prescribed date for submission of applications shall be awarded the degree at the meeting of the Senate concerned.

Provided that applications with a fine of Re. One per day may be accepted for five days after the date prescribed for receipt of applications:

Provided also that intervening holidays, if any, between the last date prescribed for receipt of applications and the last date fixed for receipt of applications with fine shall be reckoned for calculating the fine.

Provided further that, if the last date prescribed for receipt of applications or the last date fixed for receipt of applications with fine falls on a holiday for the University Office, all applications received on the next working day shall be deemed to have been received on the prescribed date.

- 2) For purpose of these Statutes, the date of receipt of applications in the University Office shall be considered as the date of receipt of the applications.

205. Validity of Diplomas:

The Diplomas of the University shall be valid only if they bear the seal of the University and are signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

- IV. That Statute 226 under Chapter XXIII be renumbered as Statute 206".

Chapter XXII thus amended would read as follows:

CHAPTER XXII.

Award of Degrees.

201. Award of Degrees:

- 1) Degrees shall be awarded at any ordinary meeting of the Senate.
- 2) All Degrees except Honorary degrees shall be awarded in absentia.

202. Date of application:

Candidates for degrees must submit to the Registrar their applications for degrees in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee, remitted in the prescribed manner 30 clear days before any meeting of the Senate.

203. Fees:

A candidate applying for a degree shall pay a fee of B.20/--, which shall be in addition to the fees prescribed for the various Diplomas.

204. Applications to be made in the prescribed manner:

- 1) No candidate who has applied without the fees prescribed or who has not applied in the manner prescribed before the prescribed date for submission of applications shall be awarded the degree at the meeting of the Senate concerned.

Provided that applications with a fine of Re. One per day may be accepted for five days after the date prescribed for receipt of applications:

Provided also that intervening holidays, if any, between the last date prescribed for receipt of applications and the last date fixed for receipt of applications with fine shall be reckoned for calculating the fine:

Provided further that, if the last date prescribed for receipt of applications or the last date fixed for receipt of applications with fine falls on a holiday for the University Office, all applications received on the next working day shall be deemed to have been received on the prescribed date.

- 2) For purpose of these Statutes, the date of receipt of the applications in the University Office shall be considered as the date of receipt of the applications.

205. Validity of Diplomas:

The Diplomas of the University shall be valid only if they bear the seal of the University and are signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

course of study and passed the prescribed examinations :

Diploma in Consumer Electronics and TV Technology."

IV. Amendment to statute 169 under Chapter XIV -  
Degrees, Diplomas, Certificates and Titles

"That the Diploma in consumer Electronics and TV  
Technology be added, under statute 169 as item No. (vi)  
and the list of Diplomas and certificates be accordingly  
renumbered."

The Statute 169 as amended would read thus :

In exercise of the powers conferred on it under sub section (2) of section 39 of the Cochin University of Science and Technology Act, 1986 (Act 31 of 1986) the Syndicate at its meeting held on 19.6.1999 amended Statute 93 in Chapter V of the Cochin University First Statutes 1980 and added a new Chapter, Chapter XII B after Chapter XII A of the Cochin University First Statutes 1980. These amendments are effective from 15th day of December 1999, the date of assent by the Chancellor as required under sub section 4 and 5 of section 39 of the said Act.

II. Amendments/New Statutes to the Cochin University First Statutes 1980.

1. (a) That the existing provision in (IX) under 'Chapter V Faculties - 93 Faculties' be replaced by " The Faculty of Medical Science and Technology".
- (b) The following be added as 93(x) " Such other - Faculties" as may be instituted from time to time".

With the additions incorporated, statute 93 will read thus:

CHAPTER V

93. Faculties:

The following shall be the faculties in the University namely:

- (i) The Faculty of Humanities
- (ii) The Faculty of Law
- (iii) The Faculty of Marine Sciences
- (iv) The Faculty of Science
- (v) The Faculty of Social Sciences
- (vi) The Faculty of Technology
- (vii) The Faculty of Engineering
- (viii) The Faculty of Environmental Studies
- (ix) The Faculty of Medical Science and Technology
- (x) Such other Faculties as may be instituted from time to time.

2. (a) That a new Chapter viz " CHAPTER XII-B. Faculty of Medical Science and Technology" be incorporated after "CHAPTER XII-A".

- (b) That the following new Statutes be incorporated under CHAPTER XII-B. Faculty of Medical Science and Technology as 154(d), 154(e) and 154(f).

154(d) Degrees:

The Degrees under the Faculty of Medical Science and Technology shall be Graduate and Post Graduate in emerging areas of Medical Sciences and Technology.

154(e) Other Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates:

The University may award any other Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates as may be instituted from time to time in the Faculty of Medical Science and Technology

154(f) Award of Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates:

The Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates shall be awarded as per the conditions stipulated in the Regulations for the award of such degree/diplomas/certificates.

Chapter XII B will thus read as follows:

CHAPTER XII B

FACULTY OF MEDICAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

154(d) Degrees:

The Degrees under the Faculty of Medical Science and Technology shall be graduate and post graduate degrees in emerging areas of Medical Sciences and Technology.

154(e) Other Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates:

The University may award any other Degree or Diplomas or Certificates as may be instituted from time to time in the Faculty of Medical Science and Technology.

154(f) Award of Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates shall be awarded as per the conditions stipulated in the regulations for the award of such Degrees/ Diplomas/Certificates.
