ICCR Scholars – Revised HRA Claim from ICCR and Special Allowance to ICCR Scholars -
Resolution of the Syndicate – Orders Issued

ORDER

The University has provided admission to some foreign students through ICCR and all these students are from very poor African Countries. ICCR reimburses tuition fees and HRA per annum in a flawless manner. The University claims ₹2000/- per month per candidate as HRA from ICCR. ICCR has no provision to allot any amount to the mess expenses of the scholars.

Considering the poor financial condition of the present ICCR Scholars, the Director, IRAA has recommended to claim maximum admissible amount (i.e. ₹4500/-) from ICCR as HRA. After receiving the claimed amount from ICCR, an amount of ₹2500/- per month be given as Special Assistance from the University to each ICCR Scholar.

Considering the matter in detail, the Vice Chancellor has approved the recommendation of the Director, IRAA subject to ratification by the Syndicate.

The Syndicate, at its meeting held on 17/11/2017, considered along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance & Purchase, the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor approving the recommendation of the Director, IRAA to claim the maximum amount of ₹4500/- from ICCR as HRA and to release an amount of ₹2500/- as Special Allowance to ICCR scholars.

The syndicate resolved to ratify the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor.

Orders are issued accordingly.
